

Ethical approvals for CFAS

MRC Cognitive Function and Ageing Study (CFAS) was approved locally at all sites from 1991, after the introduction of Multi-centre research ethics committees the study continued to apply for both Multi-centre and local research ethics committee approval at each centre. The local research ethics committees and multicentre ethical committees have changed titles many times over the previous 25 years as demonstrated below.
